GOOD TO KNOW

The Year of Biodiversity is drawing to a close. At the World Summit on Sustainable Development in Johannesburg 2002, the present countries set the goal to slow down biodiversity loss significantly by 2010, in the face of the accelerated species extinction and the loss of habitats. Previous measurements showed a further loss of biodiversity, but there are positive trends in the conservation areas, whose size has doubled in the last 20 years to 12% of the

land areas. Also, the water quality has improved significantly. The greatest success is likely to be raising awareness of the need for action.
